

**Meeting for Parents of Freshman Students To Introduce Maumee's New 1 to 1 Technology Initiative & Sign up for your Child to Participate**

**December 1 from 6 – 7 p.m. in the MHS Cafeteria OR December 5 from 7:30 – 8:30 a.m. in the Performing Arts Center at MHS**

Maumee's new *1 to 1 Technology Initiative* will provide a Chromebook computer for every freshman, that he/she may use at school, take home, and then own outright at graduation. You have the choice to fully participate in this initiative, as there is a \$30 annual assessment for your high school student's computer.

**For your child to fully participate in the 1 to 1 Technology Initiative, attending a parent meeting is required.**

If you are not able to attend a meeting or do not want to pay the annual assessment, your child will be issued a district Chromebook each day after arriving at school.

Part of Maumee School's strategic plan is to engage students in learning that is relevant to real life. One of the ways this is happening is through the district's *1 to 1 Technology Initiative* that will put a computer into the hands of every student in grades 4 – 9. Then, each year an additional grade will be added until the *1 to 1 Technology Initiative* is in grades 4 – 12. Only high school students will be able to take computers home with them and the only part of the initiative that has a financial assessment for the device.

Moving to 1 to 1 means that all students have the opportunity to collaborate, experiment and creatively apply educational concepts using technology.

Much more information will be provided at the parent meeting and there will be plenty of time for questions & answers. There will be a discussion about when/how to pay the \$30 annual assessment, how repairs will be handled, student responsible use procedures, and much more. There will also be participation paperwork for parents to complete.

Computers will be distributed during the first or second week of January 2017.
