



Maumee City Schools Will Host a Meeting for Parents of Students Entering Kindergarten in the 2017-18 School Year

When: Thursday, March 9, 2017 @ 6:30 pm

Where: Performing Arts Center at Maumee High School, 1147 Saco St.

Any child who resides in the Maumee City School District and will be five-years-old by August 1, 2017 is eligible to attend kindergarten this fall. Unless a child successfully completes a kindergarten program he/she is not permitted to enter first grade.

An informational meeting is planned for parents of children entering kindergarten in the 2017-2018 school year. This meeting will inform parents about kindergarten expectations and what you can do to prepare your child for entering kindergarten.

Enrollment/registration packets will be available at the meeting. Required documents and immunization information will be discussed at the meeting. Parents will learn how Maumee's online enrollment/registration process works and how to self-schedule their child for a kindergarten screening appointment in March.

If you are unsure if your child should attend Fairfield Elementary School or Fort Miami Elementary School, neighborhood lists will be available at the information meeting, or you can call one of the buildings or the administration office.
