Hello parents,

Based on the guidance provided to us by Governor DeWine as well as the Lucas County Health Department, Maumee City Schools is planning for in-person classes, Monday – Friday, for students in all grades. There will also be an option for parents who want their children to learn virtually rather than returning to in-person classes. Specific details about both learning options will be released no later than July 27. We anticipate that school start and dismissal times will remain the same and bus transportation will be available this school year, as in past years, however, registration will be required so that the school district can ensure we are providing a safe environment for our students and drivers.

Just like in past summers, Maumee has an online back-to-school form and it is now ready for you to complete. You access the form by logging into your PowerSchool Parent Portal account. (It is not accessible through student accounts.) A form is needed for every student, including those who attend Penta and Union Preschool. If you need assistance with your Parent Portal account, please call 419-893-3386 option 2 or 419-893-8778 option 2.

Look for the link named “Back to School Form” once you are [logged into PowerSchool](#). Having your Parent Portal set up is the necessary first step to completing your child’s back-to-school form.

Maumee’s August Back-to-School Registration Day has been canceled. Much of the back-to-school business normally taken care of at Registration Day in August will be handled directly by schools once the new year begins. This includes paying fees, Chromebook pick up (MHS), receiving agenda book/planner (GMS & MHS), buying locks & gym shirts (GMS), turning in immunization records, updating medication information, and verifying residency.

Information such as supply lists, school fees, bus routes, school breakfast & lunch information will be posted throughout the summer as it is finalized so be sure to visit the [back-to-school page of the school district website](#) for this information.

Please check your email often in the coming days as we have a great deal of information to communicate with our families. The school district and individual school principals will be utilizing SchoolMessenger emails for most of this correspondence.
