New Information

Picking Up Student Belongings From School Buildings

Later this week, you will receive an email with information about picking up your child's remaining items from our schools and returning items that are school district property. The last day of classes for students is Friday, May 22. Chromebooks and textbooks will not be collected until the last week of May and details about this will be forthcoming (the only exception is graduating seniors). A schedule and procedure details for belongings pick up will be emailed to parents (via SchoolMessenger). Buildings will be open for pick up only May 12, May 13 and May 14. Our three elementary schools will handle this by drive-thru pickup/dropoff of items. One member of a family (parent or student) may enter Gateway and Maumee High School.

MHS Graduation Ceremony Set For Saturday, May 23

Members of the Maumee High School Class of 2020 will take part in their commencement ceremony on May 23. Grads and parents will receive specific details by email from Mr. Dick tomorrow morning (4/29/20). The Maumee community and out-of-town family and friends will be able to watch the ceremony live streaming from the Performing Arts Center at Maumee High School, beginning at 9 a.m. Family members (up to 4) will be invited into the Performing Arts Center at a scheduled time slot to see their graduate walk across the stage for their diploma presentation. Safety protocols, including everyone wearing a mask or face covering, will be in place and social distancing will be maintained. At the conclusion of what will most likely be seven-hours of presenting graduates with their diplomas, the live-streamed video will be edited down and every graduate will have access to download a copy.

Maumee Summer "Academic" Camp and Summer "Youth Sports" Camps

We have not been able to make final decisions about IF or WHEN these Maumee summer camps will be able to be held. As the Governor puts out additional guidance about his *Responsible Restart Ohio* plan, we will be able to finalize camp plans, including if we will be able to hold them or not and communicate this information to parents.

How Final Grades via Remote Learning Will be Calculated

The school district is finalizing how 4th quarter and 3rd trimester grades, as well as final grades, will be calculated this year. These details will be shared with parents/students later this week. Students are expected to continue to be engaged with their assigned remote learning experiences and continue to make progress in their learning. This includes demonstrating engagement by logging into their courses and completing and submitting assignments and activities. If students need extra support, these students (or parents for younger children) should be reaching out to teachers with questions, needs, and concerns.
