### **Free Breakfast & Lunch Available for Children Ages 1 - 18**

Maumee City Schools is offering school-day breakfast and lunch meals for **all children ages 1 - 18** during the weeks of virtual instruction (currently through January 8, 2021). You only need to register your children once (not weekly). Upcoming meal pick-up dates are Monday, December 21, Monday, December 28, and Monday, January 4.
