Daily Internal Briefings Begin Tomorrow - 3/17/20

Beginning tomorrow as part of our emergency response plan we will hold internal briefings to ensure we are addressing pressing issues and communicating critical information with you. I will continue to provide you with daily updates until further notice.

New Contact Number

Given our school building offices are closed until further notice, we are asking parents to call 419-720-3285 if you need to reach our schools. As part of our emergency plan, this is the number to be used as we will have someone answering these calls and will respond to messages as soon as possible. All building phones will soon be forwarded to this number as well.

Modified Teaching Instruction to Begin this Wednesday - 3/18/20

Please be sure to check your email for further direction from your child's teacher(s) in regard to their plans for instruction. Once again, please keep in mind that we are encouraging staff to use new technology resources and platforms and your patience and understanding are appreciated as there will be a learning curve for all involved. Each teacher will be working to do their best to accommodate their classes. We all understand that parents and students and teachers will not be available 24/7. This will look different for our kindergarten students than it will our AP classes. I would encourage you to contact your child's teacher if you have specific questions.

Gateway and Fairfield students can pick up devices at the Gateway Learning Center by entering door #15 located on the northwest side of the building from 6AM to 6PM on Tuesday, March 17th. *If you requested a device and cannot pick one up on Tuesday, devices will be available at our administrative offices located at 716 Askin Street on Thursday, March 19th and Friday, March 20th between 8AM and 3 PM.*

Due to the most recent guidance provided to us, we will not be able to provide internet access within our school buildings. However, we are working to make our internet available in our parking lots. Additional updates will be provided.
