## Daily PANTHER PLEDGE

**Student:** I pledge to stay home from school if I have any symptoms of COVID-19.

**Parent:** I pledge to keep my child home from school if he/she has any COVID-19 symptoms and to report absences to the school attendance secretary. If my child has been in close contact with a person who has COVID-19, I will quarantine him/her at home. By allowing my child to be at school or placing him/her on the school bus, I am assuring the district and other parents that my child is not ill and is fever-free.

**Symptoms within last 48 hours that indicate someone may have COVID-19:**

- new cough (or change in baseline)
- fever (100.4 degrees or higher)
- new onset severe headache
- sore throat
- vomiting or diarrhea
- abdominal pain
- loss of taste or smell

**Remember these important health habits:**

**Wash hands. Practice good hand hygiene by washing your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Use an elbow if no tissue is available. Do not share personal items – pens, pencils, cell phones, electronic devices, laptops, water bottles, drinks, food, or unwashed utensils. Avoid close contact with people who are sick. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth whenever possible.**
